ORDER BELOW EXH.13

1. Perused the application at Exhibit No. 13 moved by the applicant. It is contended that respondent No. 1 is attempting to change his residence with a view to obstruct compliance of this Court's order dated 11/08/2025 passed on Exhibit No. 9, whereby interim custody of the minor child Priesh was directed to be handed over to the applicant. It is further stated that the applicant has come to know that the minor child has sustained a fracture injury on his hand due to a fall from a motorcycle while in the custody of respondent No. 1. This fact, according to the applicant, demonstrates that respondent No. 1 is not taking proper care of the minor child, thereby endangering his health and safety.

2. Considering the tender age of the child and the observations already recorded in the order on Exhibit No. 9 regarding the paramount importance of the child's health, safety, and welfare, this Court is satisfied that immediate and effective implementation of the custody order is necessary. For this purpose, police assistance is required so that the interim custody can be smoothly and safely handed over to the applicant. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1.	The application at Exhibit No. 13 is allowed.
2.	The Miraj Rural Police Station is directed to render necessary assistance to the applicant for securing and ensuring the safe handover of minor child Priesh to

	the applicant, in terms of the interim custody order passed by this Court on Exhibit No. 9.
3.	The Protection Officer shall also remain associated with the said process and shall submit a compliance report to this Court forthwith.
