

ORDER BELOW EXH.10 IN RCC NO.449/2025

Accused has forwarded this bail application through Jail Authority. It is his contention that, the charge-sheet is filed. The matter is pending. Therefore, he prayed to release him on personal bond.

02. Perusal of record and order below Exh.01, it appears that, he has no Advocate. Therefore, the Advocate is provided through Taluka Legal Services Authority, Miraj. However, he denied it and submitted to give time to appoint his Advocate. Meanwhile, this application is forwarded by accused.

03. The learned APP submitted his say that accused is habitual and hardened criminal. Therefore, there is possibility that accused may absent or flee from trial. Thus, prayed to reject the application.

04. The offence levelled against accused are under Section 309(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. He is in jail since 20/08/2025. The charge-sheet reveals that, another offence under Section 103(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 is also levelled against accused. He is in jail for that offence also. In the present case, the charge-sheet is filed.

05. The accused is not required to keep behind the bar. The investigation is completed. The trial will take its own time to conclude. Therefore, the circumstances are not such that to keep him behind the bar. The case is not exceptional case. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following order :

ORDER

1. Accused be released on bail on executing his P.R. bond of Rs.15,000/- with surety in like amount.
2. Accused shall not pressurize the informant and witnesses witness relating to this case.
3. Accused shall not contact any person directly or indirectly relating to this case.
4. Accused shall furnish P.R. bond of Rs.15,000/- and after release, he shall furnish surety bond in like amount.
5. Inform the concerned Jail Authority through e-mail.
6. The Jail Authority shall forward his P.R. bond to this Court and release forthwith, if not required in any other case.
