

Order Below Exh.1 in RCC No. 61/2014
(State Vs. Baban Bansode)

This is a regular criminal case which is pending since very long because of continuous absence of accused. It is seen that the Court has issued number of summons and warrants, and taken all the efforts to secure presence of accused. However, the prosecution agency could not secured presence of absconding accused. The Hon'ble High Court has issued directions that all the matters more than 10 years old shall be disposed-off expeditiously. Hence, in such circumstances, it becomes incumbent to proceed as per S.299 of Cr.P.C. in absence of absconding accused. Thus, the prosecution is directed to produce all their witnesses on next date without fail, including the informant, panch witnesses and other key witnesses to their case. The prosecution side shall note that if they fail to secure presence of their witnesses and do not examine them on next date, the necessary further order would be passed. Hence, the matter be posted for recording evidence of all the witnesses of prosecution side as per S.299 of Cr.P.C.
