

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN RCC NO. 133/2023

Perused the complaint, verification of witnesses and the documents produced along with complaint. It appears that the complainant has filed the present complaint for the offence punishable under Section 211 of Indian Penal Code, 1860. As per provision under Section 195 (1)(b) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 the cognizance of offence under Section 211 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 is expressly barred except on the complaint in writing of that Court or by the such officer of the Court as that Court may authorize in writing in this behalf or some other Court to which that Court is subordinate. Considering the provision under Section 195 (1)(b) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the question arose as to the maintainability and cognizance of present complaint by and in this Court. Therefore, the case is posted for argument on aforesaid question. On failure of such argument, the case will be posted for passing further consequential order.
