From perusal of the case record, it appears that the complainant filed this case against four persons named in the complaint petition u/s 420/406/34 of the I.P.C. From perusal of the case record, it further appears that complainant got herself examined on SA and also examined four witnesses namely 1) Satendra Pandey, 2) Shankar Mahato, 3) Rounak Kumar and 4) Latru Kumar Rawani u/s 202 Cr.P.C. The complainant and the witnesses have supported the facts that the accused persons committed cheat with the complainant. A prima-facie case u/s 420/409/34 of the I.P.C. is made out. Hence, <u>cognizance</u> is taken for the offence u/s 420/409/34 of the I.P.C. On further perusal, I find that there is sufficient materials available on record to proceed against accused persons namely 1) Nakul Mahato, 2) Sakhi Chandra Mahato and 3) Vikash Mahato as named in complaint petition. Hence, the above named accused persons are summoned to face trial. Office is directed to issue summon against three accused persons namely 1) Nakul Mahato, 2) Sakhi Chandra Mahato and 3) Vikash Mahato. There is no materials available on the case record to proceed against rest one person as named in the complaint petition. The complainant is directed to file necessary requisites within seven days and after receipt of requisites, O/c is directed to issue summon to the accused persons named above.
