

**Order below Ex.1 in Civil.M.A 48/2024
Murtuj Mulla Vs Nil**

The application is under Section 2 of the Bombay Regulation, 1827.

2 Persued the application, and the record.

3 Heard.

4 Brief facts:- Applicant 1 is the mother of deceased Paigambar Mirasab Mulla, applicant 2 is wife, and applicants 3 and 4 are the children of deceased Paigambar, who passed away on 02/04/2022 at Ankalgi Dist.Sangli. The deceased Paigambar, has no other legal heirs other than the applicants. The heirship certificate is requested for compensation from Maharashtra State Electricity Board, (MSEB) Sankh and other purpose etc.,

5 To substantiate the claim, the applicants have relied upon the evidence in the form of affidavit-in-lieu of examination-in-chief of applicant 2 below Ex.11. The applicants have relied upon the documentary evidence viz., Adhaar Card of Applicants 1 to 4 below Exh.4/Sr.Nos.1 to 4 respectively. Death certificate of deceased Paigambar Mirasab Mulla is below Exh.14. Rationcard is below Exh.4/Sr.No.2.

6 No one has objected to the instant proceedings, despite issuance of public notice below Exh.10. The applicants have duly paid the Davndi Fees of Rs.10/- (receipt No.82, and 130). The applicants have closed their further evidence below Ex.13. The addresses of the applicants and that of the deceased is the same. The death certificate of the deceased when considered with the Adhar Cards of the applicants, and the fact that the application is on affidavit, there is no reason to take a contrary view, when no one has objected to the claim. The same has been sought for by the applicants for the heirship certificate for compensation from MSEB, Jath and any other purpose etc.,. Even otherwise, the proceedings is for formal recognition of being the legal heirs of the deceased. In short, no right is accrued or taken away by the issuance of the said certificate. Hence, the following

Order

The application is allowed.

- 2 The applicants are formally recognized as the legal heirs of the deceased Paigambar Mirasab Mulla.
- 3 Issue certificate in the prescribed format, on due compliance.
