

**ORDER BELOW EXH.05 IN RCS NO. 15/2024**


Read the application, perused the documents on record. The suit is for partition, separate possession and injunction. The learned advocate for plaintiff didn't appear and pressed for ad-interim injunction. Thus, considering the nature of dispute and valuable rights of defendants involved in the suit property, it is just and proper to hear other side before passing any ad-interim order. However, it appears that address of defendant no.6 and 7 is not mentioned in the suit though injunction is sought against them. Hence, it would be proper to issue directions in it's regard. Thus, issue show cause notice to defendant no 1 to 5 as to why injunction should not be granted. Plaintiff is directed to do the needful for providing address of defendant no.6 and 7.
