**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 27****IN RCS NO. 31/2025**

(Bhimrao Metkari Vs. Damodar Metkari)

1] The plaintiff has filed application for extension of status quo order till next date. The plaintiff has also filed a separate application for short adjournment as plaintiff is residing at Gujrat and some material documents and photographs are with him and he is not well. Hence, the plaintiff has prayed to extend status quo order and grant adjournment.

2] The Advocate for defendant has resisted the application. The Advocate for defendant submitted that, he have already filed say on temporary injunction application below exhibit 5 and he is ready to argue on the matter. The Advocate has specifically submitted to vacate the stay order as there is no substance in the application and defendant is ready to argue on merits.

3] Heard both the Advocates. It is pertinent to note here that, the last date was 12/03/2025. On that date, defendants have files and the Advocate was ready to argue on exhibit 5 on 12/03/2025. With consent of both the Advocates, the matter was posted on today's date for arguments on exhibit 5. Considering the seriousness of the matter, the plaintiff ought to have remain present before the Court on today's date and proceed with the matter. This Court has also given earliest date considering the urgency in the

matter and the status quo granted by the Court.

4] The status quo order was passed by the Court on 06/02/2025. As per the provisions of law, the temporary injunction application has to be decided within 30 days from the date of passing status quo order. Considering this provision, the 30 days period has completed on 06/03/2025. Accordingly, the application has to be disposed of on merits as early as possible. The Advocate for plaintiff is seeking adjournment for 8 days. I do not find any substance to grant adjournment of 08 days. Considering all this facts and circumstances, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application Exhibit 27 is allowed and status quo order is extended till next date i.e. 20/03/2025.
- 2) A short adjournment is granted till 20/03/2025.
- 3) Failure to argue on exhibit 5 on 20/03/2025 by either side, the party will face the consequences and matter shall proceed further.
- 4) Costs in cause.
