**ORDER BELOW EXH. 5**

Heard advocate for plaintiff. Perused the documents filed along with suit. Suit is filed for declaration and perpetual injunction. It is submitted by the advocated that defendant Nos. 1 and 2 are claiming ownership and possession over suit property No.1A and restraining to cut and transport the standing sugar cane in the suit property No.1A. I have gone through the documents more particularly the extract of 9(3)(4), Sale-deed of defendant, 7/12 extract, copy of N.C., photographs. Prima-facie it can be seen that, property of plaintiff i.e. suit property 1A Gat No.491 and property of defendant i.e. Gat No.482 are to distinct properties. Prima-facie plaintiff will suffer from irreparable loss in case the standing sugar cane crop is not transported to the factory within few days. Prima-facie the plaintiff has made out extraordinary circumstances to consider the ad-interim application and to grant ad-interim injunction against defendants. Accordingly, I proceed to pass following order.

**ORDER**

1. Ad-interim injunction is granted and defendant Nos. 1 and 2 are hereby temporarily restrained from obstructing the possession (i.e. cutting of standing sugar cane and transporting to factory) of plaintiff over suit property 1A till filing their say returnable on 07/03/2026.

2. Plaintiff to comply provisions of Order XXXIX  
Rule 3(a)(b) of Code of Civil Procedure.
3. E.P. & S.B. allowed.
