ORDER BELOW EXH.68

Accused No.2 is released on bail on 15/10/2025 for the offence punishable under Section 454, 380 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. But due to non compliance of bail conditions accused is in jail since then. Thereafter, accused file an application for his release on personal bond.

2. The learned advocate for the accused has submitted that, accused is poor person and financial condition of accused is extremely dire. There is no one in his family who can comply bail conditions. Therefore, the learned advocate for the accused prayed to release him on personal bond and grant time to fulfill the bail conditions.

3. The learned A.P.P. has filed his say and submitted that, offence is serious in nature. Therefore, if he is released on personal bond there is possibility that he may tamper evidence and he may be abscond. Hence, it is prayed that application to be rejected.

4. Heard the learned advocate for the accused and learned A.P.P.

5. From the perusal of record, it appears that, the accused is released on bail on 15/10/2025. Financial condition of accused is extremely dire. Therefore, there is no one from his family to comply with the bail conditions. The accused is ready to comply with the bail conditions after his release from jail. Considering the circumstances in the present case, it would be proper to relax the bail conditions and to release him on personal bond and grant time to fulfill bail conditions. In result I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. The accused is released on executing personal bond in the amount of Rs. 25,000/-.
3. The accused is directed to furnish S. B. in the amount of Rs. 25,000/- within 8 days from his release.
4. He shall furnish his permanent address proof, his mobile phone number and names, addresses and mobile phone numbers of his two near relatives.
5. The accused shall remain present on each scheduled date.
