

**Order below Exhibit 94 in Regular Civil Suit no. 115/2014**

1. The plaintiff has filed the present application to bring on record legal representatives of defendant no. 10 on record. The plaintiff contended that the defendant no.10 died on 14/10/2021. His legal representatives could not be brought on record within stipulated period. It is necessary to bring on record legal representatives of defendant no.10 by deleting the name of defendant no.10. Hence prayed to allow the application.

2. The defendants resisted the application contending that the application is filed deliberately belated and need not be allowed. Hence prayed to reject the application.

3. Perused the application and say. Heard both side. On perusal of the record it is appears that the suit is pertaining to declaration and perpetual injunction. The the defendant no.10 died on 14.10.2021. There legal representatives could not be brought on record within stipulated period. An opportunity needs to be given to the legal representatives of the defendant no.10 to put forth their case in the interests of justice which will ultimately help in adjudicating of the matter on merit as of the necessary parties to the suit should be on record. Accordingly, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

1. Application Exh.94 is allowed subject to costs of Rs.200/- paid to the defendants.
2. The plaintiff is allowed to bring the legal representatives of the defendant no.10 on record of the suit within 14 days of this order.
