- 1) This application is filed by plaintiff to serve the summons and notice to defendant nos.6(a) to 6(d) under the provision of O.V, R.20 of C.P.C.
- 2) Perused the application, affidavit filed in lieu of this application (Exh.51), copy of assessment extract of house of defendant nos.defendant nos.6(a) (Exh.53/1).
- 3) The Bailiff report below Exh.49 mentioned the reason that defendant no.defendant nos.6(a) to 6(d) were not found at their address. Therefore, summons could not be served upon them.
- 4) As per O.V, R.20, a summons can be served in the manner provided under above provision, where the court is satisfied that the defendant is keeping out of the way for the purpose of avoiding the service, or that for any other reason the summons cannot be served in ordinary way. In this instant case, there is reason to believe that the summons on defendant no.defendant nos.6(a) to 6(d) can not be

served in ordinary way therefore substitute service is required.

5) Defendant no.6(a) is living at house no.7-A at village Tadsar, Tal.Kadegaon, Dist.Sangli. The copy of assesment extract is on record. Defendant no.6(b) is brother and defendant nos. 6(c) & 6(d) are sisters of the defendant no.6(a). Therefore, summons can be served to them on address of the defendant no.6(a).

6) Therefore, this is a fit case to issue summons as per O.V, R.20. on given address Hence, I pass following order

**ORDER**

1. Application is allowed.
2. Summons to defendant nos.6(a) to 6(d) be served by affixing copy of summons by affixing copy on conspicuous part of the house of defendant no.6(a) on given address i.e. house no.7-A at village Tadsar, Tal.Kadegaon, Dist.Sangli.
