2. I have carefully perused the complaint, affidavit of verification, documents produced along with the complaint on record. I have myself made inquiry under Section 202 of Code of Criminal Procedure and examined the witness of complainant on affidavit. There are sufficient grounds to proceed with against the accused. The presumption provided under Section 118 and 139 of the Negotiable Instrument Act are prima-facie established. The complaint is filed within prescribed limitation. The offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act is prima-facie made out against accused. Hence, issue process against the accused for offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, on P.F. and also to supply the copies of the complaint and other documents filed along with it, to the accused within three days from today.
