



COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH.47, 49 & 51 IN
RCS No.1138/2020

(Gokula Kadam & Ors Vs.Bhimrao Chandanshive & Ors)

The application moved on 16.01.2026 to condone the delay to bring legal heirs on record and setting aside abatement order. The plaintiff No.1 Gokula Hanmant Kadam died on 21.06.2025. It is contention that the plaintiff's legal heirs that that they have no knowledge that the legal heirs has to brought on record for proceeding in matter. Therefore, the delay so caused to bring legal heirs on record. The defendants have not filed say on it. He argued on the application. The suit is for declaration and perpetual injunction. Hence, the legal heirs of the deceased plaintiff are necessary to bring record. They are necessary parties. Hence application is allowed. The plaintiffs are directed to carryout amendment as per rules.
