



ORDER BELOW EXH.25 IN
REGULAR CIVIL SUIT No.1588/2020
(Sukhdev Khandare Vs. Tukaram Khandare & Ors)

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff and defendants. The application is filed by the defendant No. 1 to 7 to set aside no written statement and *exparte* order passed against them. The plaintiff filed say at Exh. 27. The Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff argued that no written statement order passed against defendant No. 1 to 7 after giving sufficient opportunity to file written statement. Hence, it is necessary to reject the application. The suit is for partition. To decide suit on all issues, it is necessary allow the application as well as this is first and original Court hence it is necessary to allow the parties to contest their matter. At same time, it must be keep in mind that the no written statement order was not passed immediately. But after giving sufficient opportunity to the defendants then order was passed. Hence, it is necessary to imposed costs on the defendant No.1 to 7. The application is allowed on the costs of Rs.1,000/- (one thousand only) be paid to Legal Aid Authority, Vita.
