

**Order below Exh.4 in Sessions Case No.9/2026**  
**(CNR No.MHSN170000922026)**  
**(State of Maharashtra vs. Rajaram Namdev Shinde & Anr.)**

1. This is an application filed by applicant/accused No.1 Rajaram Namdev Shinde for return of property under Section 497 of the B.N.S.S. The State filed its say at Exh.8. Read application and say. Heard both sides. Perused the record.

2. It is not disputed that Hero Honda Company's Splendor Plus motorcycle bearing RTO registration No.MH-10-AH-3537 is seized in crime No.171 of 2025 by Chinchni-Wangi Police Station registered under Sections 118(2), 118(1), 119(2), 126(2), 324(2), 352 r/w. 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. It is also not disputed that applicant/accused No.1 is the registered owner of the said vehicle. Name of the applicant is not mentioned in the FIR. The vehicle was seized from applicant/accused No.1 in above crime number. Copy of the registration certificate filed along with list Exh.6/1 shows that the vehicle is standing in the name of applicant/accused No.1. It is not the case that the said vehicle is required for any examination or in the trial. If it is not handed over to its registered owner, it would lie in the police station and will reduce to scrap. Therefore, it is necessary to return it to applicant/accused No.1. Hence, application can be allowed. Accordingly, I pass the following order:-

**: O R D E R :**

1. Application Exh.4 is allowed.
2. Hero Honda Company's Splendor Plus motorcycle bearing

RTO registration No.MH-10-AH-3537 seized in crime No.171 of 2025 by Chinchni-Wangi Police Station registered under Sections 118(2), 118(1), 119(2), 126(2), 324(2), 352 r/w. 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 shall be handed over to applicant/accused No.1 Rajaram Namdev Shinde on executing indemnity bond of Rs.30,000/- and on condition that, he shall not transfer it to third party and shall not change its appearance. He shall produce it as and when required by the Court. The vehicle shall be handed over after taking its photographs from all sides at the expenses of applicant/accused No.1.

3. Application is disposed of accordingly.
