**State Vs. Akash Tulajaram Balramwale**

**Order Passed Below Exh. 6**

1. This application is filed by accused No. 4 Laxmi Akash Balramwale @ Laxmi Bapu Lokare under section 439 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under sections 103(1), 324(5), 155(2), 352(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and under section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) & 3(2)(va) of Atrocity Act.
2. As per the oral argument and contents of application it is the case of accused No. 4 that, she is falsely implicated in the crime. She is innocent and has not committed any crime. She was arrested on 28/12/2025 and since then in M.C.R.. She is ready to remain present in the Court on every date. She is lady having children and nobody is there to look after the children. She is ready to follow the terms and conditions of the bail. Therefore, she may be released on bail.
3. The learned A.P.P and informant have filed their say and opposed the application. As per their say and oral argument it is their case that, nature of offence is serious, non bailable and punishable with life imprisonment. The cause of death is head injury. Charge sheet shows active involvement of the applicant. Her role is clearly mentioned. If she is released on bail, then there is possibility of tampering with the evidence

and witnesses. Filing of charge sheet shows that, there is strong evidence against the applicant. The applicant has instigated co-accused to commit the serious offence. The applicant through others is consistently threatening the informant and trying to pressurize the witnesses. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides. Perused report and charge sheet. From report it prima facie appears that on 17/10/2025 at 11:00 p.m. the informant heard hue and cry. Therefore, she went in front of Sangharsh Tarun Mandal, Garibi Hataav Zopadpatti No. 1, Vijapur Road, Solapur and found that co-accused Akash Tulajaram Balramwale and Naval Khare were assaulting her husband Yatiraj by fist and kick blows. Akash Balramwale was saying that “तु मला दारु पिण्यास का पैसे देत नाही म्हणून तुला बघून घेतो”. He brought axe from his house and given blow on the head of husband of informant from backside. So, the informant along with the help of friend of her husband Viresh Rampure took her husband in hospital. However, on 18/10/2025 at 12:05 a.m. her husband was died.

5. Though, in the report name of applicant is not mentioned, in the investigation it was revealed from the statements that the applicant along with co-accused have in furtherance of their common intention assaulted the husband of informant by fist and kick blows. The applicant instigated her husband Akash Tulajaram Balramwale to assault the husband of informant. At the instigation of applicant co-

accused No. 1 Akash Balramwale has given blow of axe on the head of husband of informant from backside. Cause of death is head injury. Thus, nature of offence and the manner in which it was committed is very serious. The charge sheet shows that, there is strong evidence against the applicant. In such circumstances, if the applicant is released on bail, then there is possibility of absconding of the applicant, pressurizing the witnesses, commission of serious offence against the informant and tampering with the evidence. Hence, at this stage, the present application deserves rejection. Hence, following order is passed.

**ORDER**

Bail Application is rejected.
