Order Passed Below Exh. 9

1. This application is filed by accused No. 2 Naval Suresh Kare under section 483 of B.N.S.S. for the offences punishable under sections 103(1), 324(5), 115(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S. and under section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) & 3(2)(va) of Atrocity Act.
2. As per the oral argument and contents of application it is the case of accused No. 2 that, he is innocent and has not committed any offence. He is falsely implicated in the crime. Investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed. Nothing is to be recovered from the accused. He is ready to follow the terms and conditions of bail. He will not threaten or pressurize the witnesses. Therefore, he may be released on bail.
3. The learned A.P.P. and informant have filed their say and opposed the application. As per their say and oral argument it is their case that, nature of offence is very serious, non bailable and punishable with imprisonment for life. The cause of death as mentioned in the P.M. notes is head injury. Charge sheet shows active involvement of the accused No. 2. In the crime his role is clearly mentioned. If he is released on bail, then there is possibility of tampering with the evidence and

witnesses. Filing of charge sheet shows that, there is strong evidence against the applicant. The applicant has instigated co-accused to commit the serious offence. There is sharing of common intention. If the accused No. 2 is released on bail, then possibility of his absconding, pressurizing and threatening the witnesses and tampering can not be ruled out. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides. Perused report and charge sheet. From report it prima facie appears that on 17/10/2025 at 11:00 p.m. the informant heard hue and cry. Therefore, she went in front of Sangharsh Tarun Mandal, Garibi Hatav Zopadpatti No. 1, Vijapur Road, Solapur and found that co-accused Akash Tulajaram Balramwale and accused No. 2 Naval Khare were assaulting her husband Yatiraj by fist and kick blows. Akash Balramwale was saying that “तु मला दारु पिण्यास का पैसे देत नाही म्हणून तुला बघून घेतो”. He brought axe from his house and given blow on the head of husband of informant from backside. So, the informant along with the help of friend of her husband Viresh Rampure took her husband in hospital. However, on 18/10/2025 at 12:05 a.m. her husband was died.

5. In the report itself it is clearly mentioned that accused No. 2 along with Akash Balramwale have assaulted deceased Yatiraj by fist and kick blows on account of not giving money for consuming liquor. Subsequently Akash Balramwale has given blow of axe on the head from left side to deceased Yatiraj. At that time accused No. 2 was present over there. He

has not stopped Akash Balramwale from giving blow of axe on the head of deceased. On the contrary, he has instigated co-accused Akash Balramwale to give the aforesaid blow of axe. Thus, there is instigation and sharing of common intention at the hands of accused No. 2.

6. Nature of offence and the manner in which it was committed is very serious. The charge sheet shows that, there is strong evidence against the accused No. 2. In such circumstances, if the accused No. 2 is released on bail, then there is possibility of his absconding, pressurizing the witnesses, commission of serious offence against the informant and tampering with the evidence. Hence, at this stage, the present application deserves rejection. Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

Bail Application is rejected.
