**Order Below Exh.4**

1. By judgment dated 16/12/2025 passed in RCC No.917/2017 by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Solapur, appellant is convicted of offences PUS 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, for offence PUS 82 (a)(c)(d) of The Registration Act. Learned CJM has sentenced the appellant to suffer SI for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.3,000/- for offence PUS 420 of IPC, to suffer SI for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- for offence PUS 465 of IPC, to suffer SI for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.3,000/- for offence PUS 467 of IPC, to suffer SI for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.3,000/- for offence PUS 468 of IPC, to suffer SI for two years and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- for offence PUS 471 of IPC and to suffer SI for one year and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- for offence PUS 82 (a)(c)(d) of Registration Act.

2. It does not appear to be in dispute that the accused was on bail during trial. It also does not appear to be in dispute that after recording the judgment of conviction, learned CJM has suspended the sentence till filing of appeal or till expiry of appeal period. Accused has challenged the said judgment of conviction by filing this appeal. His learned Advocate submitted that the appellant has good chances to succeed in the appeal. Appeal is the statutory right of the convicted

appellant/accused hence, it is necessary to suspend the substantive sentence of conviction till final decision of the appeal. Thus, an order.

**ORDER**

1. Applications Exh.4 is allowed as under :-
2. The substantive sentence of conviction passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate vide judgment dated 16/12/2025 in RCC No.917/2017 is stayed till final decision of the appeal, on executing PB and SB in the sum of Rs.15,000/- by the appellant.
3. Inform the learned CJM Court, accordingly.
