ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 1

This is an application seeking the amount lying in the name of late mother of the applicant Sushilabai Hanmant Tate vide TDR No. 6042402233 for Rs. 50,000/-.

02. It is the contention of applicant that, due to sustaining of injuries in an accident by his mother, the M.A.C.P. No. 163 of 2001 was filed which has been decided on merits and she has been awarded amount of Rs.1,35,900/- as a compensation. Out of said amount, an amount of Rs.50,000/- has been deposited in the Fixed Deposits as per order of the Court. However, said could not be withdrawn due to her sudden demise on 7.8.2013.

03. Perused report of Sr. Clerk, M.A.C.T., Solapur, informing that an amount of Rs. 50,000/- is invested in F.D. on 14.6.2012 in the name of Sushilabai Hanmantrao Tate i.e. mother of applicants.

04. Learned advocate for the applicant submits that the applicants are entitled to the said amount of compensation being heirs of Sushila. Further more, he has submitted on record the heirship certificate issued by the Civil Court in the name of applicants. On going through the said heirship certificate, it is crystal clear that the applicants are the legal heirs of late Sushilabai. Therefore, they are entitled for the same. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

- i) M.A.C.P. M.A. No. 20/2026 is allowed.

- ii) The Manager, Indian Bank, branch at Solapur is directed to verify and transfer the amount of Rs.50,000/- alongwith interest accrued thereon standing in the name of Sushilabai Hanmantrao Tate i.e. mother of applicants Uttam Hanmant @ Hanmantrao Tate and Sangita Popat Magar in M.A.C.P .No. 163 of 2001 to the bank account of the applicants and report to Nazir, District Court, Solapur, accordingly.

- iii) Application is disposed of.
