**Seema Naganath Kumbhar Vs. State**  
(CNR No. MHSO010004742026)

**Order Passed Below Exh.1**

1. This application is filed by **Seema Naganath Kumbhar** for anticipatory bail under section 482 of B.N.S.S. in Crime No. 682/2025 Akkalkot North police station for the offences punishable under sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of The Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and under section 115(2), 333, 352, 351(3), 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

2. In the application the applicant has reproduced contents of F.I.R.. As per the oral argument and contents of application it is the case of the applicant that, she is innocent and has not committed any crime as alleged in the report. There is no prima facie evidence against her. Investigation is practically completed. Nothing is to be recovered from her. Therefore, her physical presence for interrogation is not required. She is ready to follow terms and conditions of bail. Hence, she may be released on bail.

3. The informant and learned A.P.P. have filed their say

and opposed the application. They have reproduced contents of F.I.R. in their say. As per the contents of say and oral argument it is their case that nature of offence is very serious. Investigation is in progress. If the applicant is released on bail, then she will pressurize the witnesses, abscond, commit serious offence and do not cooperate with the investigation. Her custody for interrogation is required. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides at length. Perused the report. On 17/08/2025 there was quarrel took place in between Nagesh Kumbhar and informant. They have assaulted son of informant by iron rod. Since his wife is bedridden due to paralysis and Nagesh Kumbhar is of quarreling nature, he has not filed report. On 07/10/2025 Nagnath Kumbhar and his wife i.e., the applicant have filed false report against the son of informant. On 09/10/2025 at 06:30 p.m. Nagesh Kumbhar and his wife i.e., applicant, their son Prathamesh and sister Tarabai came in their house and abused that, “मादरचोद मांगट्यांनो तुम्हाला फुकटचे खायची सवय लागली आहे. आता फुकटची जेलची हवा खा.” Thereafter, Nagesh Kumbhar and Prathamesh Kumbhar have dragged informant, his son Shivaji out of their house and assaulted them. The applicant has dragged wife of informant. The applicant and Tarabai have abused to wife of informant and thereafter threatened them.

5. From the report it prima facie appears that, role of

the applicant is only limited to dragging the wife of informant and abusing her in filthy language. In the report itself it is not the case of the informant that, applicant has abused him or his family members on caste in public place. Hence, prima facie case is not made out against the applicant. Besides, in the report itself informant has stated that, prior to lodging this report, Nagesh and applicant have lodged report against the son of informant. Therefore, possibility of lodging false F.I.R. to give counterblast to the earlier F.I.R. can not be ruled out.

6. Besides, the alleged incident took place on 09/10/2025 and report is lodged on 04/12/2025 belatedly. There is no satisfactory explanation given by the informant. On this count alone the report becomes doubtful. There is no possibility of pressurizing the witnesses and misusing the liberty granted to the applicant. Hence, present application deserves to be allowed. Resultantly, following order is passed.

### **ORDER**

1. Anticipatory bail application is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest of applicant **Seema Naganath Kumbhar**, she be released on bail on executing P.B. and S.B. of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) in Crime No. 682/2025 Akkalkot North police station for the offences punishable under section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2) (va) of The Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act

and under section 115(2), 333, 352, 351(3), 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita on following conditions :-

- (i) The applicant shall not commit any offence in future.
- (ii) The applicant shall follow terms and conditions of the bail.
