Ramchandra @ Nana Nagnath Jadhav Vs. State
(CNR No. MHSO010004772026)

1. Applicant **Ramchandra @ Nana Nagnath Jadhav** has filed this application for regular bail in Crime No. 36/2026, registered with Kamati police station for the offences punishable under section 118(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2)(3), 3(5) of B.N.S. and under sections 3(1)(r)(s) and 3(2)(va) of The Scheduled Castes and The Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

2. The applicant has reproduced contents of report in the application. As per the contents of application and oral argument it is his case that, he is innocent and he has not committed any offence. He is involved in the false and afterthought complaint due to local groupism or political rivalry. There is delay in lodging the F.I.R. which creates doubt about the prosecution story. Investigation is practically completed and there is no need of further custodial interrogation. There is no any criminal antecedents against him. He is having firm roots in the society. He is ready to furnish surety. He will not tamper or hamper with the prosecution evidence. Therefore, he may be released on bail.

3. The learned A.P.P. and informant have filed their say and opposed the application. As per their say and oral argument, it is the case of prosecution that nature of offence is very serious, non bailable and anti-social. There is involvement of the applicant in the crime. Investigation is in progress. Weapon used in the commission of offence i.e. iron bar is yet to be seized. The applicant is criminal minded & Gunda. There is terror of applicant in the village. If he is released on bail, then he will flee away and create hurdle in the investigation of crime and will not cooperate with the investigation. He will pressurize the witnesses and tamper the evidence. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides at length. Perused report and case diary. It prima facie appears from the report that on 09/02/2026 the informant has given horn of his car to Nana Nagnath Jadhav for giving side. That time Nana Jadhav was riding motorcycle. Nana Jadhav has abused the informant that “मांगट्या दम निघत नाही का”. Thereafter, the informant came at his house. That time Nana Jadhav came along with Rama Jadhav in front the house of Vikas Patil and started abusing the informant that “मांगट्या लई मस्ती आली काय”. Thereafter they have abused and assaulted the informant. Nana Jadhav has given blow on his back by iron rod. That time Sandhyarani Vikas Patil and others came to rescue the dispute. She asked why you are assaulting. That time Nana Jadhav and Rama Jadhav told that “तुम्ही मांगाची पोरं घेऊन फिरता, तुमचे नवरे हंडगे आहेत, तुम्हाला रंडक्या करतो, तुमच्यात कोण गडी माणूस आहे,

मी जेलमध्ये बसतो पण तुम्हाला सोडत नाही, जेलमध्ये बसलो तर बसतो पण बाहेर आल्यावर विष्णू बाळा होतो, तुमच्यात कोणाला जिवंत ठेवत नाही.” The Rama Jadhav has catch hold the hand of Sandhyarani and twisted it. Applicant has given blow of iron rod on her shoulder. Rama Jadhav has pushed her and she fell down. Thereafter, Rama Jadhav ran away from the spot of incident. Whereas applicant was catch hold by the public.

5. From the report it prima facie appears that applicant and Rama Jadhav have given the aforesaid abusals to Sandhyarani. However, who has given which abusals has not been specified in the report. In the report the informant has not mentioned caste of the applicant.

6. It is pertinent to note that the applicant was arrested on 10/02/2026 and since then he is in M.C.R. Muddemal is already recovered. Investigation is on the verge of its completion. There is no possibility of tampering with the evidence, pressuring the witnesses and absconding of the applicant. Therefore no purpose will be served by keeping the applicant behind bars for indefinite period. Hence, present application deserves to be allowed.

ORDER

01. Regular bail application is allowed.

02. Applicant **Ramchandra @ Nana Nagnath Jadhav** be released on regular bail on executing

PB. and S.B. of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) in Crime No. 36/2026 registered with Kamati police station for the offences punishable under sections 118(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2)(3), 3(5) of B.N.S. and under sections 3(1)(r)(s) and 3(2)(va) of The Scheduled Castes and The Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act on following conditions.

- (i) The applicant shall not commit any offence in future.
- (ii) The applicant shall not pressurize, threaten and influence the witnesses.
