1. Applicant **Dada Magar Fadatare** has filed this application for regular bail under section 483 of B.N.S.S. in Crime No. 241/2026 registered with Faujdar Chawdi police station for the offences punishable under sections 115(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5), 85 & 89 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and under section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. The applicant has reproduced contents of report in the application. As per the contents of application and oral argument it is his case that, he is innocent and he has not committed any crime. He was arrested on 28/02/2026 and from 02/03/2026 is he in M.C.R. He has not demanded dowry. Contents of F.I.R. and allegations made therein are false. The abortion of Sakshi did not took place due to beating by applicant. Abortion of Sakshi took place due to hard work of filling water and moving heavy objects done by her in the house of her maternal aunt Pooja Siddhaganesh before one day of abortion. The allegations regarding illicit relations of applicant with another woman are false. No such incident took place as alleged in the report. The applicant is ready to follow the terms and conditions of bail. Therefore, he may be released on bail.

3. The informant and learned A.P.P have filed their say and opposed the application. They have reproduced contents of report in their say. As per the contents of say and oral argument it is their case that, nature of offence is serious, there is active involvement of the applicant in the crime. Investigation is in progress. If applicant is released on bail, then there is possibility of absconding of applicant, pressurizing the witnesses, tampering with the evidence and commission of serious offence against the informant and witnesses can not be ruled out. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides at length. Perused report along with case diary and documents. It prima facie appears from the report that on 04/02/2024 marriage of daughter of informant i.e., Sakshi took place with applicant. Thereafter on account of illegal demand of dowry, gold ornaments and domestic reasons the applicant along with co-accused have subjected Sakshi to physical and mental ill-treatment. They have demanded dowry of Rs. 15 lakhs. When the applicant is having knowledge that Sakshi is pregnant, that time on the count of illegal demand he has given kick blows on her abdomen and thrown her on ground. Therefore, there was miscarriage. Subsequently Sakshi has taken medical treatment to that effect.

5. It is necessary to point out that, there is no dispute about the fact that Sakshi was pregnant and there was miscarriage. In the report itself and from case diary it prima facie appears that there are specific allegations against the applicant

that, he has assaulted Sakshi by kick blows on her abdomen and thrown her on ground, therefore there was miscarriage. Thus, the manner in which the applicant has committed aforesaid offence is very serious. When the applicant is having knowledge about the pregnancy of Sakshi, inspite of that giving kick blows on her abdomen and throwing her on ground shows the brutality and conduct of the applicant. Investigation is in progress. In such circumstances, if the applicant is released on bail, then possibility of commission of serious offence against Sakshi, threatening the witnesses and tampering with the evidence can not be ruled out. Therefore, application deserves rejection. Resultantly, following order passed.

ORDER

Application is rejected.
