ORAL ORDER

(Passed on 01/04/2026)

1. This is an application for grant of regular bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
2. Read the application and say. Heard learned advocate Shri.Matre for the applicant/accused and learned APP Smt.Deshpande for the prosecution. Perused the entire record.
3. Allegations in the FIR, in brief, are as under;
On 20/02/2026 at about 9.00 pm, informant and his friends Mayur Pujari and Sunil Shinde were chitchatting in front of house of Nilesh Irkal at Ashanagar, MIDC, Solapur. Akash Bhairamdagi, Ritesh Bahiramdagi, Raj Bharle and Aditya Moharkar (applicant/accused) called the informant near them. Co-accused Akash Bhairamgade stabbed knife on the chest of the informant. His brother Ritesh gave a blow of some sharp edged weapon on the seat (hip) of the informant. Co-accused Raj Bharale and applicant/accused Aditya Moharkar caught-hold the informant and that time, co-accused Raj Bharale took the knife from co-accused Akash and gave a blow of it on the backside portion of waist of the informant. Informant sustained bleeding injuries and he was admitted in Civil Hospital. He lodged report on 21/02/2026 of the said incident on the basis of which, crime as mentioned above came to be registered against applicant/accused and

others at PS. MIDC, Solapur.

4. Learned advocate for applicant/accused argued that informant has falsely implicated the applicant/accused in false crime. He argued that there are no allegations that applicant/accused was having any rivalry with the informant before incident & there are no allegations that applicant/accused made assault on the informant by any weapon. He argued that applicant/accused is under detention since last more than one month, applicant/accused is ready to abide by the conditions imposed by this Court hence, applicant/accused may be enlarged on bail.

5. As against this, learned APP argued that applicant/accused with the help of other co-accused persons attempted to commit murder of the informant by making use of deadly weapons, investigation is still in progress, applicant/accused will pressurize the informant and other witnesses hence, applicant/accused is not entitled for bail.

6. I have gone through the investigation papers made available by learned APP. Having gone through the contents of FIR and statements given before police and learned JMFC by the informant, substance is found in the argument of learned advocate for the applicant/accused that there are no allegations that applicant/accused himself made assault on the informant during incident either by any weapon or otherwise. The only allegation against the applicant/accused is that he had caught hold the informant after which, co-accused Raj Bharale dealt blow of knife on the waist of the informant from backside.

7. Applicant/accused is a teenager boy aged 19 years as can be seen from the copy of his Aadhar Card wherein, his date of birth has been recorded as 08/09/2006. It does not appear that anything in connection with the crime is either seized or has remained to be seized from the

applicant/accused. Considering the role attributed to the applicant/accused in commission of the crime and considering the fact that he is a teenager boy, this Court is of the opinion that it would be in the interest of justice to direct his release on bail. So far as the anxiety expressed by the learned APP that applicant/accused may tamper with prosecution evidence by pressurizing the informant and other witnesses is concerned, it can be taken care of by imposing suitable conditions on the applicant/accused while directing his release on bail. Thus, an order :

ORDER

(a) Criminal Bail Application No.192/2026 is allowed.

(b) Applicant/accused Aditya Mukund Moharkar be enlarged on bail in Crime No.223/2026 registered at P.S.MIDC, Solapur for offences PUS 109 (1), 118 (2) rws 3 (5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita on his executing PR bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- with one solvent sureties in the like amount.

(c) Applicant/accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner.

(d) Applicant/accused shall make himself available for interrogation purposes as & when required by the Investigating Officer.

(e) Applicant/accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to the informant or any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the facts of the case to the Court or to the police officers.

(f) Applicant/accused shall attend the concerned police station on every Sunday and Wednesday between 11.00 am to 1.00 pm till completion of investigation.

(g) Applicant/accused shall submit copy of his Aadhar Card or PAN Card or Driving License as his ID proof.
