Criminal Bail Application No. 195/2026
Deepak Bhujang Koli etc. 1 Vs. State
(CNR No. MH50010006222026)

Order Passed Below Exh.1

1. Applicant No. 1 **Deepak Bhujang Koli** and applicant No. 2 **Bhujang Dattu Koli** have filed this application for regular bail under section 483 of B.N.S.S. in Crime No. 136/2026 registered at Mohol police station for the offences punishable under section 103(1), 238, 352, 351(3), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and under sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of The Scheduled Castes and The Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

2. The applicants have reproduced contents of report in the application. As per the contents of application and oral argument it is their case that, they have not committed any offence and they are falsely involved in this crime. The missing report filed at Vairag police station falsify all allegations in the F.I.R.. Moreover, there is delay in lodging F.I.R. The applicant No. 2 is 78 years old aged person and suffering from various ailments. They are ready and willing to follow the terms and conditions of bail and will not abscond. They will not tamper the evidence. Therefore, they may be released on bail.

3. The learned A.P.P. and informant have filed their say and opposed the application. As per their say and oral argument it is their case that, nature of offence is serious and punishable with life imprisonment. There is active involvement of the applicants in the crime. Investigation is in progress. If the applicants are released on bail, then they will abscond and create hurdle in the investigation. They will not cooperate. They will bring pressure on the informant. There is possibility of commission of serious crime against the informant. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides at length. Perused report and case diary. It prima facie appears that on 21/02/2026 at 01:30 p.m. the applicant No. 1 and 2 have assaulted husband of informant by stick on account of causing damage to the glass of Scorpio vehicle. They have threatened and abused on caste to the husband of informant. Since then the husband of informant is missing. The applicants have abused the informant that, "महारड्यांनो आमची गाडीची काच फोडायला समजत नाही का, तुझा पती कुठे गेला ते बघं, तो कुठेपण दिसला तर त्याला सोडणार नाही, आमचे गाडीची काच भरून द्या, तर आम्ही त्याला सोडू, नाही तर त्याचा उद्याचा दिवस दिसू देणार नाही". On 24/02/2026 at 12:30 p.m. in the river bed at Valuj husband of informant was found dead. Hence, the applicants have committed murder of her husband.

5. In the report itself the role of applicant No. 1 and 2 is clearly mentioned that, on 21/02/2026 the applicants have

assaulted by stick to the husband of informant on account of causing damage to the glass of their Scorpio vehicle. Since then, he is missing. They have also abused the informant on her caste and threatened her. The dead body of her husband was found in river bed on 24/02/2026 at 12:30 p.m.. One belt was found around the neck of the husband of informant. Thus, nature of offence is very serious. On the neck of husband of informant one belt is found. The witness has stated that, husband of informant was beaten by sticks by the applicants. All the aforesaid circumstances speaks with volume that, there is involvement of the applicants in the crime. Investigation is in progress. In such circumstances if applicants are released on bail, then there is possibility of commission of serious offence against the informant and witnesses, absconding of applicants, pressurizing and threatening the witnesses and causing obstruction in the investigation. Hence, at this stage present application deserves rejection. Resultantly, following order is passed.

ORDER

Regular bail application is rejected.
