1. This application is filed by **Nirmala Bhujang Koli** for anticipatory bail under section 482 of B.N.S.S. in Crime No. 136/2026 registered at Mohol police station for the offences punishable under section 103(1), 238, 352, 351(3), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and under sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of The Scheduled Castes and The Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

2. The applicant has reproduced contents of F.I.R. in application as per contents of report and oral arguments it is the case of the applicant that, she is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. She has not abused the informant on caste. Only on suspicion and due to enmical terms with the family of applicant, she is falsely implicated in the crime. Her husband and son were arrested. Therefore, she is apprehending arrest at the hands of police. Hence, she may be released on anticipatory bail.

3. The learned A.P.P. and informant have filed their say and opposed the application. As per their say and oral argument it is their case that, nature of offence is serious and punishable

with life imprisonment. There is active involvement of the applicant in the crime. Investigation is in progress. If the applicant is released on bail, then she will abscond and create hurdle in the investigation. She will not cooperate. She will bring pressure on the informant. There is possibility of commission of serious crime against the informant. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides at length. Perused report and case diary. It prima facie appears that on 21/02/2026 at 01:30 p.m. the husband and son of applicant have assaulted husband of informant by stick on account of causing damage to the glass of Scorpio vehicle. They have threatened and abused on caste to the husband of informant. Since then the husband of informant is missing. The husband and son of applicant have abused the informant that, "महारड्यांनो आमची गाडीची काच फोडायला समजत नाही का, तुझा पती कुठे गेला ते बघं, तो कुठेपण दिसला तर त्याला सोडणार नाही, आमचे गाडीची काच भरुन द्या, तर आम्ही त्याला सोडू, नाही तर त्याचा उद्याचा दिवस दिसू देणार नाही". The applicant has also abused the informant on caste and threatened her. On 24/02/2026 at 12:30 p.m. in the river bed at Valuj husband of informant was found dead. Hence, the applicant, her husband and son of have committed murder of her husband.

5. In the report itself the role of husband and son of applicant is clearly mentioned that, on 21/02/2026 they have assaulted by stick to the husband of informant on account of

causing damage to the glass of their Scorpio vehicle. Since then, he is missing. The informant along with her husband and son have abused the informant on her caste and threatened her. The dead body of her husband was found in river bed on 24/02/2026 at 12:30 p.m.. One belt was found around the neck of the husband of informant. Thus, nature of offence is very serious. The witness has stated that, husband of informant was beaten by sticks by the husband and son of applicant. All the aforesaid circumstances speaks with volume that, there is involvement of the applicant, her husband and son in the crime. Investigation is in progress. In such circumstances if applicant is released on bail, then there is possibility of commission of serious offence against the informant and witnesses, absconding of applicant, pressurizing and threatening the witnesses and causing obstruction in the investigation. Hence, at this stage present application deserves rejection. Resultantly, following order is passed.

ORDER

Anticipatory bail application is rejected.
