1. By filing this application, applicant has prayed to relax the condition imposed on her by the Court while allowing her Criminal Bail Application No.53/2026 by order dtd.10/02/2026.
2. Read the application and say. Heard Ld. Advocate Shri. Koli for the applicant and Ld. APP Smt. Deshpande for the State. Perused the entire record.
3. The copy of order dtd.10/02/2026 passed in Criminal Bail Application No.53/2026 by District Judge-5 and Additional Sessions Judge, Solapur is placed on record by the applicant. Its perusal shows that while directing release of the applicant on bail, condition is imposed on her to attend concerned police station on every Saturday in between 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. till filing of charge-sheet. Applicant has prayed in her application to relax the said condition by submitting that she is permanent resident of Pune having a child aged 04 months. Contention raised to that effect in the application is supported by the copy of birth certificate wherein the date of birth of the child of the applicant is noted as 03/12/2025. A period of around two months has already elapsed since after imposing of the condition on the applicant to attend the P.S. concerned. Applicant has produced on record copies about her attending the police station as per the directions of the

Court. Considering the reason mentioned in the application, though the prosecution has objected the application, this Court is inclined to accept the prayer made in the application but with certain modification. Thus, an order.

ORDER

1. Criminal M.A. No.35/2026 is allowed as under.
2. Condition imposed on the applicant Sejal Milind Kirnikar to attend P.S. concerned on every Saturday in between 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. till filing of charge-sheet is hereby relaxed with direction that she shall attend said police station as and when summoned in writing by the investigating officer.
3. Inform the P.S. concerned accordingly.
