1. The applicant No. 1 **Balasaheb Kashinath Banagar** and applicant No. 2 **Vitthal Vishambar @ Vishwanath Bandgar @ Banagar** have filed this application for anticipatory bail under section 482 of B.N.S.S. in Crime No. 127/2026 Karmala police station for the offences punishable under sections 132, 121(1), 118(1), 189, 190, 191, 351(2) & 352 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and under section 92 of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

2. The applicants have reproduced contents of report in the application. As per the oral argument and contents of bail application it is the case of the applicants that, they are innocent and they have not committed any offence. The allegations made in the report are false. Nothing is to be recovered from them. Therefore, their presence for custodial interrogation is not necessary. They are having firm roots in the society. They are ready to cooperate with the investigation. They will not tamper with the evidence and pressurize the witnesses. They are ready to furnish surety. Therefore, they may be released on bail.

3. The learned A.P.P and injured have filed their say and opposed the application. As per the contents of say and oral argument it is the case of prosecution that, nature of offence is serious. There is active involvement of the applicants in the crime. Investigation is in progress. The applicants are absconding since commission of offence. Custody of the applicants is required for the purpose of investigation and interrogation. If the applicants are released on bail, then they will bring pressure on the witnesses, create hurdle in investigation and will not cooperate with the investigation officer. The applicants are having criminal background. The applicants are habitual offenders and serious offences are registered against them at Karmala police station. There is terror of applicants in the village. Therefore, application may be rejected.

4. Heard both sides at length. From the report it prima facie appears that, on 17/02/2026 at 05:40 p.m. at village Vihal, Tal. Karmala in Gat No. 140/1 the informant being working as Measurer in Bhumi Abhilekh Karyalaya, Karmala went for measurement. That time, applicants along with co-accused have started threatening the informant. When the informant was doing measurement that time the applicants and co-accused obstructed his official work. Thereafter, they have started quarreling with each other. So, the informant went to rescue their quarrel. However, the applicants and co-accused

have assaulted him. Co-accused Jeevan Vishwambhar Bandgar has given blow on his right hand by measurement pipe.

5. The allegations against applicant No. 1 are that, he has caused obstruction in the official work of informant and assaulted the informant by fist and kick blows. It is not the case of the informant that the applicant No. 2 has assaulted him. On the contrary, it is his case that applicant No. 2 was involved in assaulting the injured Hausarav Bandgar, Ramchandra Bandgar, Sukhdev Bandgar, Vaijanath Bandgar, Pranav Bandgar and Annasaheb Bandgar by stone.

6. It is necessary to point out that, during the course of investigation except the applicant No. 1 and 2 all other accused were arrested and the measurement pipe along with stone has been seized. The applicants alleged to have committed offences punishable under aforesaid sections to which punishment is not more than 7 years. Now, nothing is to be seized from them. In such circumstances, if they are kept behind bars, then no purpose will be served. There is no possibility of tampering with the evidence and pressurizing the witnesses. Investigation is almost completed. Therefore, there is no possibility of causing obstruction in the investigation at the hands of applicants. Hence, present application deserves to be allowed. Resultantly, following order is passed.

ORDER

1. Anticipatory bail application is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest of applicant No. 1 **Balasaheb Kashinath Banagar** and applicant No. 2 **Vitthal Vishambar @ Vishwanath Bandgar @ Banagar**, they be released on executing P.B. and S.B. of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) each in Crime No. 127/2026 registered at Karmala police station for the offences punishable under sections 132, 121(1), 118(1), 189, 190, 191, 351(2) & 352 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and under section 92 of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 on following conditions :-
 - (i) The applicants shall not commit any offence in future.
 - (ii) The applicants shall not threaten, influence or pressurize the witnesses.
 - (iii) The applicants shall attend Karamala police station on every Monday and Friday from 01:00 p.m. to 03:00 p.m. till filing of charge sheet.
