ORDER BELOW EXH.1

(Delivered on 23rd day of June, 2026)

1. Heard learned advocate for the applicant and learned APP for the State. Perused the application, say filed by the investigation officer and record.

2. This is an application filed under section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in crime No.347/2026 registered with South Akkalkot Police Station for the offences punishable under section 190, 191(2), 191(3), 352, 351(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

The allegations, in brief are as under :-

3. It is alleged that, in the month of May, 2026, dog has taken bite of goat of one Ganpati Bandichhode. On 05/06/2018 at about 10.30 a.m., the informant and other reputed persons from their community had gathered for discussing about the same and that time, this applicant claimed to have slapped on the face of the son of the informant. When the informant inquired about the same, that time, brother of this applicant namely Guddusab Shaikh arrived there running and assaulted on the head of the informant by a knife and neck and tried to kill him.

When one Sidhappa Birajdar tried to intervene, said Guddusab assaulted on the head and neck of Siddhappa by a knife and then, all accused persons beat the informant with fist and kick blows. He shouted loudly, therefore, crowd gathered there and accused went away from there. In view of such allegations, aforesaid crime came to be registered.

4. The applicant is seeking anticipatory bail on the ground that, she has been falsely implicated in the present crime and no crime as alleged is committed by her. It is further claimed that, though the investigation is practically completed, she apprehends arrest at the hands of police and considering the allegations, her custodial interrogation is not necessary.

5. The prosecution opposed the application on the ground that, the offence is of serious nature and the allegations shows involvement of the applicant in commission of crime and prayed to reject the application.

6. In so far as allegations against this applicant are concerned, it is merely alleged that, she slapped son of the informant and thereafter, this applicant accused Guddusab and all other accused persons beat the informant and considering the allegations against this applicant, it is apparent that, her custodial interrogation is not necessary for the purpose of investigation directing this applicant to co-operate in the investigation will suffice. Hence, she is entitled for the relief as prayed. Hence, the following order is passed.

ORDER

1. Cri. B. A. No. 567/2026 is allowed.

2. In the event of arrest, applicant Hasina Gulab Jamadar be released on bail in Crime No. 347/2026 registered with Akkalkot South Police Station, upon executing personal bond of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand only) with surety in like amount.
3. The applicant shall not tamper with prosecution witnesses, nor shall make any attempt to interfere with the investigation.
4. Cri. B. A. No. 567/2026 stands disposed off accordingly.
