COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH.1

(Delivered on this 06th day of July, 2026)

1. Heard learned advocate for the applicants and learned APP for the State. Perused the applications and say filed thereon.
2. Since both the applications are considered together, the applicants therein are mentioned by their names.
3. By both the applications, the applicants are praying to grant anticipatory bail in Crime No. 465/2026 registered with Mohol Police Station for the offences punishable under section 118(1), 118(2), 115(2), 189(), 191(2), 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

The case of the prosecution, in brief, is as under :-

4. When the informant along with his parents was working in the agricultural land, that time, all the applicants along with co-accused arrived there and accused Tukaram told the informant that, he will not cohabit with his sister and assaulted on the head of the informant by Axe and brother of the informant by STP Pipe. They beat the parents of the informant by fist and kick blows, that time, the informant and his

brother went to intervene and then applicant Jakudev caught hold of the informant and applicant Dasharath caught hold of the brother of the informant and the applicant Vishal assaulted the informant by wooden stick and accused Sagar assaulted brother of the informant by hockey stick and that's how, the informant and his brother got injured, in view of which, aforesaid crime came to be registered.

5. Apprehending arrest at the hands of police, the applicants are seeking anticipatory bail on the ground that, they have been falsely implicated in the present crime and no allegation of any assault with deadly weapon are leveled against these applicants and therefore, their custodial interrogation is not necessary.

6. Both the applications are strongly opposed by the prosecution on the ground that, the crime is of serious nature and custodial interrogation of the applicants is necessary and prayed to reject the application.

7. In so far as the applicants Jakudev, Dashrath and Birudev are concerned, the allegations against applicant Jakudev and Dasharath are of only holding hand of the informant and brother of the informant, while, no role is attributed to the applicant Birdev.

8. However, there are allegations of assault by the stick against the applicant Vishal, which prima-facie shows his involvement in commission of crime. Certainly, the informant and his brother has sustained injuries and considering the assault so made by the applicant Vishal by stick on the informant, it can not be said that, his custodial interrogation is not warranted.

9. In so far as other three applicants are concerned, considering the role attributed to them it is apparent that, their custodial interrogation is not warranted and purpose can be served by directing them to attend the police station and co-operate in the investigation. Hence, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail in Criminal Bail Application No. 551/2026, while, Criminal Bail Application No. 559/2026 deserve to be allowed. Hence, the following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1 Cri. B. A. No. 551/2026 is rejected.
- 2 Cri. B. A. No. 559/2026 is allowed.
- 3 Applicant No.1 Jakudev Ramchandra Dudhal, applicant No.2 Dasharath Hanumant Masal and applicant No. 3 Birudev Sadashiv Masal be released on bail in Crime No. 465/2026 registered with Mohol Police Station, upon executing personal bond of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand only) each, with surety in like amount.
- 4 Applicants No. 1 to 3 shall attend the police station Mohol from 8th June, 2026 to 10th June, 2026 between 10.00 a.m. to 1.00. p.m. They shall co-operate in the investigation. They shall also remain present in concerned police station as and when called by the investigation officer.
- 5 The applicants shall not tamper with prosecution witnesses, nor shall make any attempt to interfere with the investigation.
- 6 In the event any breach committed by this applicant, the prosecution is at liberty to move this court for cancellation of bail so granted to applicant.
- 7 Cri.B.A. No. 551/2026 & 559/2026 stands disposed off accordingly.
- 8 Original order be kept in Cri. B. A. No. 551/2026 and copy of it, be kept in Cri. B. A. No. 559/2026.
