ORDER BELOW (EXHIBIT No.01)
(24/06/2026)

1. Perused application, say and papers of investigation. Heard Learned Adv. Mr. R. S. Mhatre, for applicant/accused and learned APP Mr. P. S. Jannu, for State.
2. Present application is filed by the applicant/accused for grant of bail in regard to the offences punishable under Sections 7, 7(A) and 12 of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered vide C.R. No.383/2026 at Akkalkot North Police Station, Akkalkot.
3. It is the case of the prosecution that, the complaint was

lodged by the complainant that the applicant and co-accused (public servants) demanded bribe amount of Rs.1,50,000/- for release of vehicle and for not implicating father and uncle of the complainant in the crime in C.R.No.366/2026 registered at Akkalkot North Police Station.

4. Learned Adv. Shri. R. S.Mhatre for the applicant submitted that the applicant is non public servant. He is not concerned with the crime. He never demanded bribe amount. The voice sample of the applicant is already obtained. The maximum punishment prescribed is upto 7 years. The verification and trap panchanama are already prepared. The bribe amount is recovered. The investigation is practically completed. He prayed for grant of bail to the applicant.

5. Per contra, vide say Exh. 6 learned A.P.P. opposed the bail application. He submitted that the applicant and co-accused demanded bribe amount of Rs.1,50,000/- and after settlement the applicant accepted amount of Rs.1,20,000/- from the complainant. The role of the applicant is specifically mentioned in the report. The investigation is in progress. The co-accused are absconding. Hence, prayed for rejection of the application.

6. Considering the matter, it is alleged the applicant is caught accepting the bribe amount at the time of trap for and on

behalf of co-accused. The bribe amount is already recovered. The verification and trap panchanama are prepared. The offences are punishable upto 7 years. No criminal antecedents are pointed against the applicant. The trial would take its own time. It would not be appropriate to keep applicant behind bar for indefinite period. Considering the matter, there would not be prejudice to the prosecution if suitable conditions are imposed to the applicant while granting bail to him. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. Criminal Bail Application No. 593/2026 is allowed.
2. Applicant- Akash Sharnappa Kadrame, be released on bail in C.R. No. 383/2026 registered at Akkalkot North Police Station, Akkalkot, for offence under Sections 7,7(A) and 12 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, on furnishing PR bond of Rs. 50,000/- with surety in the like amount.
3. Applicant shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses and shall not try to abscond.
4. Applicant shall attend the Anti Corruption Bureau, Solapur on 1st and 3rd Saturday of every month between 10.00 am to 12.00 noon until filing of charge-sheet.
5. Bail application stands disposed of.
