ORDER BELOW (EXHIBIT No.08)
(11/06/2025)

1. Perused application, say and papers of investigation filed in the charge-sheet. Heard Learned legal aid defence counsel Mr. Revan Patil, for applicant/accused and learned APP Shri. P. S. Jannu, for State.
2. The applicant has charge-sheeted for the offences punishable under Sections 399, 402 of Indian Penal Code, registered vide C.R.No.181/2014 at Vijapur Naka Police Station. The applicant is arrested on 18.12.2024. Since then he is in jail.

3. The learned advocate for the applicant submitted that, applicant is falsely implicated in the crime. The other co-accused are already released on bail. There is no recovery at the instance of the applicant. The allegations are only regarding preparation of offence. The name of the applicant was added on the basis of supplementary statement. Except two panch witnesses all are police witnesses. There is no specific role attributed to the applicant. He submitted that previous bail application filed by the applicant is rejected on the ground that accused was not ready to produce the proof in regard to his identity and address. The applicant is ready to abide the conditions imposed. Hence, prayed for grant of bail.

4. Per contra, vide say filed at Exhibit 15 learned APP opposed the application. It is submitted that initially anticipatory bail application filed by the applicant was rejected. Thereafter after arrest of applicant he has filed bail application No.180/2025 which was also rejected as document in regard to identity of the applicant was not on record. There is evidence against the applicant. He was absconding for about 10 years. There is possibility of abscondance of the applicant. Hence, prayed for rejection of the application.

5. It is the case of the prosecution that the informant PSI A.V. Patil was patrolling at about 0.47 hours alongwith other police staff near Aasara Chowk, Solapur, at that time he received information from PSO that 5 people came in front of the D.

Pharmacy College, Jule Solapur and they were acting suspiciously. Accordingly, informant and other police staff alongwith panch went at the spot and found accused persons assembled for the purpose of committing dacoity. The police caught co-accused Nos.1 to 3 at that time and seized articles such as iron knife, iron rod, screw driver, two battery cell, chilly powder and two motorcycles. It is alleged that the applicant and other co-accused ran away from the spot by taking disadvantage of the darkness. Subsequently on 18.12.2024 applicant came to be arrested. Though there are allegations against the applicant being involved in the crime, it is not the case of the prosecution that anything is recovered at the instance of the applicant. Perusal of order dated 06.03.2025 in regard to the rejection of the Cri. Bail application No.180/2025 it is observed that the accused was not ready to produce the proof in regard to identity and residence. After going through the charge-sheet, it seems that no test identification parade is conducted by the prosecution. The applicant has produced verified copy of his aadhar card alongwith the list Exh.18. The investigation of the crime is completed. Charge-sheet is filed. No criminal antecedents are pointed out against the applicant. The applicant is ready to abide the conditions imposed. Considering the nature of allegations against the applicant, there would not be prejudice to the prosecution if suitable conditions are imposed while granting bail to the applicant. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. The Application Exh.8 for bail is allowed.
2. Applicant Amol @ Somnath Dipak Jadhav, be released on bail in C.R. No. 181/2014 registered at Vijapur Naka Police Station, Solapur, on furnishing PR bond of Rs. 25,000/- with surety in the like amount.
3. The applicant shall furnish document of his permanent address as well as temporary address while furnishing surety.
4. The applicant shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses and shall not try to abscond.
5. Bail application Exh.8 stands disposed of.
