01. Heard applicant in person and learned Advocate for non applicants. Perused the application and say filed thereon below Exh.12.

02. This an application under Order XLVII, Rule 1 & 2 of the Civil Procedure Code for review of the Order below Exh.1 dated 10/07/2025 passed in Review Appln. No.2/2024.

03. Facts in brief are that, the judgment and decree was passed in Reg. Civil Appeal No.166/2017 on 11/03/2024 and seeking various modifications in the said judgment and decree, Review Appln. No.2/2024 was filed by this applicant 26/06/2024. By holding that, the application was not filed within a period of 30 days and there is no application for condonation of delay, which is more than two months, this Court has rejected the Review Appln. No.2/2024 by passing order dated 10/07/2025.

04. Being aggrieved with the same, this applicant has again

preferred present review application for review of the Order dated 10/07/2025 passed in Review Appln. No.2/2024 on the ground that, while passing said order, this Court did not consider the legal position as well as decisions of the Hon'ble Apex Court and the Hon'ble High Court could not come to the notice of this Court and the same remained to be considered and therefore review of the earlier order dated 10/07/2025 is necessary.

05. The application is opposed by the non applicants on the ground that, the review application is not maintainable by law and deserves to be dismissed with costs. It is also claimed that, the grounds so mentioned in the review application are not proper and therefore, the same can not be considered and prayed to reject the application.

06. Without touching the merits of the case, at the out set, it is important to note that, this is an application filed under Order XLVII, Rule 1 & 2 of the Civil Procedure Code. While Order XLVII, Rule 9 of the Civil Procedure Code provides as under :

“ 9. Bar of certain applications. - No application to review an order made on an application for a review or a decree or order passed or made on a review shall be entertained”.

07. Thus, the provision under Order XLVII, Rule 9 of the Civil Procedure Code makes it clear that, no application to review the order made on an application for review can be entertained. Same is the condition with the present application. This application is filed to review the order passed in Review Appln.

No.2/2024 dated 10/07/2025 and view of the bar so led down under Order XLVII, Rule 9 of the Civil Procedure Code, the application itself is not tenable and therefore deserves to be rejected. Hence, following order is passed.
