

ORDER BELOW APPLICATION EXH. 04
IN SESSIONS CASE NO. 218/2016

1 The applicants have filed present application for regular bail under Section 439 in present Sessions Case No. 218/2016.

2 Perused application, say and relevant record.

3 Heard Shri. Pawar the learned advocate for applicants and Shri. V. R. Kulkarni the learned APP for the State.

4 That the accused are facing trial for the offence pus 307, 504, 506 r/w. 34 of IPC. Informant is mother of accused No. 1 and 2 and mother-in-law of accused No. 3. It is submitted that already a separate crime was registered in respect of said chain of crime bearing CR No. 386/2015 and the same present applicants have filed Cri. Bail application No. 449/2015 and they came to be enlarged on anticipatory bail vide order dated 27.11.2015. though two different crimes are registered In fact if the FIR is perused it appears to be chain of same incident and the charge sheet also reflects the same and that is why the applicants were not arrested as their custody was not necessary

5 As per order dated 25.08.2016 interim bail was granted to the applicants. They have not taken any disadvantage of their liberty. So also, considering that the charge sheet has already filed. Custodial interrogation of the applicants is not necessary. Though the application is opposed by learned APP by saying that the matter is now committed and trial can be conducted within short period, however considering the peculiar facts of the case of registering two separate crimes in same chain of incidence and

granting of anticipatory bail in other crime eventually indicates that the applicants are required to be enlarged on bail. Even otherwise no purpose of prosecution will be served by keeping the applicants behind bar. Hence, I pass the following order.

O R D E R

- 1 The bail application at Exh. 04 is hereby allowed.
- 2 The applicants/ accused No. 2 Mangesh Namdeo Savaskar and No. 3 Ujjwala Namdeo Savaskar be released on furnishing PR and SB bond of Rs.25,000/- each with one or two sureties of like amount on the following conditions.
 - a) The applicants shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when needed.
 - b) The applicants shall not leave the jurisdiction of the Court without prior permission of the Court.
 - c) The applicants shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or any police officer.
- 3 Inform to concern Police Station accordingly.
