

PW 1 Prashant Nagnath Dalvi Present  
Further examination in chief resumed on 16.05.2026 oath on behalf  
of State through Additional Public Prosecutor Shri. Shaikh

9 On 06.08.2014 at about 7.00 a.m. we went to ACB office, Solapur accompanied with two panchas namely Phattewale and Bayas. At that time, Dy. S.P. ACB, present there. I handed over Rs.400-, 4 denomination of currency note of Rs.100. They effected my personal search through pancha witnesses in my possession Rs.250/- was found additionally. They directed me to keep these 250/- in pocket of my trouser.

10 The officers demonstrated application of anthracene powder and use of ultra violet lamp to us. All my stuff were checked through ultra violate rays, there was no shining of anthracene powder. So also 4 x 100 currency notes were also checked through ultra violate rays, they did not show application of anthracene powder. Official Shri Bhajibhakare applied anthracene powder to currency notes of Rs.100/- x 4 with the help of cotton guase. These currency notes are checked through ultra violete rays under dark, it shown shining on the notes and hands of Shri. Bhajibhakare who later on kept those currency notes 100 x 4 in left side pocket of my shirt. The articles, anthracene powder container, cotton guase was kept in one seal packet, panchas signed on the seal. Bhajibhakare had washed his hands and again checked his hands through ultra violet rays no shining was found on his hands. My shirt pocket had shown shining.

11           The demonstration of voice recorder and memory card was done before me. The 2 GB memory card was taken out from seal packet and installed in the voice recorder. It was verified that the memory card was blank and then voice recorder was hanged on my neck. It was concealed beneath my shirt. It was told to me that voice recorder should be kept on during conversation with public servant Kamble. Panch No.1 Phattewale was directed to be mindful to the conversation and I should not initiate the demand of bribe and if bribe amount is demanded and stated to be handed over to third person it be done accordingly and I should not accompany Kamble at any other place on his vehicle and on acceptance of bribe amount signal to be issued by moving left hand on head and if did not get an opportunity same signal should be given by panch witness Phattewale. The other panch will keep keen watch on it. These were the instructions given to us by Jawadwar. Prior to leaving office of ACB, again the hands of members raiding party were checked through ultra violet rays, it found clean. But, anthracene powder shine on my left pocket of shirt.

12           At about 8.45 a.m. we started from Solapur to Karkamb by cruiser jeep bearing No.MH-13-N-6312 a private vehicle driven by driver namely Bansode and along with ACB officials and two panchas and myself. All the necessary articles for raid were also carried. Bhajibhakare was directed to stay in ACB office, Solapur. We reached at Karkamb at about 11.30 a.m. We stopped near MSEB sub division office in front of road. Again it was examined that memory card was blank. It kept by in voice recorder with me. Myself and pancha witness No.1 Phattewale started walking Bhima Patbandhare Up-Vibhag Karkamb (for short 'sub-division office'). It was 11.45 p.m. when we reached there. All other members were followed us from distance and they stopped near sub-division office.

13 On that day, there was meeting in the sub-division office. Crowd was there. I had shown public servant Kamble to panch No.1 Phattewale from distance. In short time meeting started along with other officers and public servant, Kamble also joined meeting. On inquiry I came to know that meeting will continued till 4.00 p.m. I can met Kamble after 4.00 p.m. Therefore, we went back near the vehicle parked on the road and other members of raiding party also came there. We informed what had happened. We gathered and our jeep started and we stopped at distance on Jadhavvadi road. We again started at about 3.30 p.m. and again came to sub-division office and vehicle was stopped at distance on road side. Again it was make assured that memory card was blank and voice recorder was kept with me. Myself, panch No.1 Phattewale went into the office of sub-division. Others followed us keeping said distance. The meeting was continued. After short time meeting concluded. After that, I obtained signature of junior engineer on books लेरीज बेरीज तक्का (आकारणी तक्का) (List of farmers who applied for water supply accordingly the calculation of the governments fees for use of water). Thereafter we met Kamble we proceeded outside the office from steps, panch No.1 was with us. That time, Kamble made demand of bribe amount saying that when I am going to pay money to him. I replied affirmative and asked how much to pay. Kamble demanded Rs.500/- bribe amount. I told him that I have 400/- and took out four currency note of Rs.100 total Rs.400/- out of my left hand shirt pocket with my right hand and Kamble accepted it in his right hand and he counted four currency note and thereafter Kamble demanded 100 Rs. to me. He kept Rs.400/- in his left side shirt pocket. After acceptance of bribe amount by Kamble, panch No.1 Phattewale gave signal as decided. ACB officers and panch No.2, rushed there, they took out my voice recorded from me and they hold hands of Kamble. The officials made darkness around Kamble with black colour cloth and checked the hands of Kamble under ultra violet rays. It found positive.

ACB officials took Kamble inside the office. ACB officials called me after some time and checked my hands and pocket through ultra violet rays, it found positive. I narrated the entire incident through ACB officials.

14 At the time of acceptance of bribe public servant Kamble had wore white bluish shirt and currency notes. (Learned advocate for the accused did not dispute about its identification therefore, the bluish shirt will refer as **M.O.1** and currency notes as **M.O.2** being admitted to defence). I can identify if shown to me. I can identify the voice recorded in voice recorder. Accused Raosaheb Parmeshwar Kamble present before Court today. I identify him.

Cross-examination by Adv. Shri.R. N. Khandal for the accused

15 I was transferred from Karkamb to Barshi and I joined at Barshi on 07.07.2014 and I handed over charge to clerk Amar Shinde on the same day. It is true that after transfer, one has no concern with the official work of previous posting. Witness volunteers that tables were pending with me to be submitted. It is true that I did not receive written order to me to keep tables with me after transfer. It is not true that after transfer to obtain signature on tables was of work of Amar Shinde.

16 It is true that if governments servant is on leave, he must submit written application. If application is be allowed, then only leave can obtained. It is true that on 05.08.2014 and 06.08.2014 I had not submitted leave application.

17 It is not true that on 04.08.2014 and 06.08.2014 I did not meet accused Kamble. Officials rights and duties of junior engineer and of the post of clerk (दस्तर कारकून) were different. Junior Engineer was superior to

me and accused. It is not true that on 06.08.2014 when accused came outside after meeting I intentionally and forcefully thrusted currency notes in the shirt pocket of accused. It is not true that on the day of incident no work was pending with accused. It is not true that I deposed falsely in examination in chief and lodged false complaint against accused and today deposed false.

Cross-examination is over.

No re-examination.
