

**Common Order below Exh.1 in Cr. Bail Application  
No.97/2026**

Sakshi Balaso Patil and others Vs. State of  
Maharashtra

1 Present application is under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (B.N.S.S.). Crime No.30/2026 was registered at police station Mangalwedha against these applicants.

2 Heard both sides. At this stage, it is not necessary to enter into merit of matter. The applicants are charged for the offences punishable under Sec.132, 121 of BNS. Offence for which the applicants are charged is not having punishment more than seven years, therefore, police had to serve notice before taking action of arrest. Therefore, it cannot be said that there is apprehension in the mind of applicant that police would directly arrest him. Therefore, application is entitled to be dismissed. Hence, following order.

**ORDER**

- 1 Application is dismissed.
- 2 PSO Mangalwedha police station is directed to follow the procedure before effecting any arrest issuing notice as per provisions of BNS.
