ORDER BELOW EXH. 05

1. This is application filed by applicant for grant of ad interim anticipatory bail in connection with Crime No. 400/2026 registered with Mangalvedha police station.

2. Heard learned advocate Shri. Dharurkar for applicant/accused, at length. He argued that, wrong information has been supplied against the applicant. Almost investigation is completed. Hence, prayed for ad interim bail may be granted to the applicant.

3. Perused contents of application and documents filed along with it. I have gone through the FIR. The name of the applicant is mentioned in FIR as accused. The offence punishable under section. 64 (2) (m), 78 (1) of BNS and u/s 4, 6, 8, 12 of POCSO Act is registered against applicant/accused. In FIR there are specific allegations against applicant/accused are that, he repeatedly committed intercourse with victim and she gave birth to two children. The offences under POCSO Act are registered against the accused. The alleged offence is serious in nature. In my view, it is necessary to hear the victim/informant before passing any ad interim relief. To hear victim is mandatory in offences of POCSO Act. Hence, at this stage it will not be proper to grant ad interim relief to the applicant. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) The application Exh. 5 is hereby rejected.
- 2) Issue notice to the informant and prosecution for filing say on main application.
