The cognizance of the offence is already taken by the Virtual Court and a fine was proposed for summary disposal of case as per Section 208 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988. The violator has exercised option to contest the challan on web portal of virtual traffic courts and the challan is transferred to this court for further adjudication as per law.

It is prayed by accused that the violation of the traffic rule in question was not done intentionally and deliberately. It is submitted that there was an ambulance behind his vehicle due to which he had to cross the zebra crossing.

Submissions heard.

In my considered opinion, considering the fact that the offence in question was not intentional, accused stands **admonished** for the offence **u/s 184 MVA & Section 187 M.V Act, 1988**.

In view of the same, challan is hereby disposed of.
