

Order Below Exh. 04 in Sessions Case No. 48/2019
(Regular Bail).

(CNR No.-MH5005-001020-2019)

(Santosh Masal -Versus - State)

As I am passing this order just below and adjoining to this application itself, I need not reproduce its contents.

2. Even Ld. APP has endorsed his contesting say on this application itself. Hence, I need not even reproduce the contents of the contesting say.

3. Perused the application. Perused the contesting say. Perused the entire record. Heard the learned advocates appearing in this matter at sufficient length.

4. True that, final report in the form of chargesheet is placed in this Court. Also true that, this Court has even framed charge against present applicant accused. However, this fact does not automatically make entitle the accused for bail

5. From the FIR and other police documents, *modus opparendi* of the accused behind commission of the alleged offences is quite serious. The original complainant is a teenager brother of the deceased Shivani of whom the accused is alleged to have committed murder in spite of the admitted fact that, she was his wife. It is further alleged by the prosecution that, the accused often suspected character of his wife Shivani and after committing her murder, even masqueraded before the police that, it was an accidental death.

6. The complainant Dashrath is just a labour, who cuts down sugar cane crops. He and his parents are in vulnerable conditions. They are very prone to and likely to succumb easily to any pressure, if exercised on them. Considering the allegations against the accused, there is every likelihood on his part that, if released on bail, he would attempt to pressurize the complainant and/or his parents and/or any witnesses and may tamper with the evidence. Hence, in my opinion the accused does not deserve to be released on bail. Hence, this application is rejected.
