



Present application is filed to release amount of Rs.1,50,000/- seized from this applicant.

2 Learned advocate for the applicant submitted that CR No.207/2025 was registered at city police station and investigation is carried out. During the investigation this applicant was arrested by police. At that time, this applicant was having Rs.1,50,000/- in his pocket. When police took his search police seized amount. Said amount is not having any relation with crime. Therefore, the application may be allowed.

3 Learned APP submitted that this applicant would disposed of the property therefore, the application may be dismissed.

4 On perusal of record, it finds that there is no allegations regarding theft of amount or it is not case that this amount is stolen property but it was seized from the applicant. This applicant is entitled to get the said amount. Hence, the application is entitled to be allowed. Hence, following order.

ORDER

- 1 Application Exh.36 is allowed.
- 2 The interim custody of amount Rs.1,50,000/- which was seized in C.R.No.207/2025 at City police station, Pandahrpur, be given to the applicant Sandip Audumbar Mandve on executing Indemnity bond of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) on following conditions
- 2 The applicant shall not create third party interest or sale, mortgage or change the nature of currency notes till the disposal of criminal case.
- 3 The applicant shall produce the currency notes as and when directed by the Investigating Officer and Court during the trial.
- 4 The applicant shall not utilize the currency notes.

- 5 The applicant shall not utilized or let it be used in any crime.
- 6 The Investigating Officer is directed to obtain photographs of the said currency notes in question for its proper identification showing its condition as on the date of giving it to the applicant.
- 7 The applicant / accused shall deposit the said amount in bank in terms of fix deposit in his own name and receipt be filed in the Court.
- 8 Indemnity bond before Police Station City, Pandharpur.
