

Order passed below Exh.6 in Atrocity Special Case No.61/2018

This is an application filed by applicant / accused No.8 Mahesh Damu Pandhare vide Sec.6 and 10 of Passport Act, 1967. It is submitted that he is a modern farmer and he wants to adopt latest knowledge, he wants to go at Bangkok. He applied for passport application vide No.25-0056241750, however, due to this present offence, there is hurdle in going to abroad. So he prayed to give direction for verification being case pending against him. He supported his application with affidavit. He relied on application filed by him and his adhar card copy.

2 Learned APP and I.O. filed his say vide Exh.11 and 12 and strongly objected the application alleging that if he is allowed to prepare pass part then he will remain absent in the Court, therefore matter can be lingered and alternative he prayed to pass necessary order. However, the complainant has given no objection by filing his say Exh.15.

3 Heard both parties. Perused record. The applicant / accused No.8 produced his application filed before passport authority, his adhar card. On perusal of record it appears, that the applicant / accused No.8 is charged with offence under Sec.143, 147, 148, 149, 324, 323, 504, 506 of IPC and Sec.3(1)(r)(s), 3(2)(va), of SC and ST (PoA) Act, and Sec.6 and 7(1)(d) of Protection of Civil Right Act. The hearing of the trial is yet to be commenced. It appears from the record that, due to pendency of this Case, there may be hurdle in verification by police station concern. It is to be noted here that this Court has no objection for getting verification of passport by the accused but if he wants to go outside the country, permission of this Court is required. The application is deserves to allowed as prayed. In view of the same, following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1 Application vide Exh.6 is allowed as below.
- 2 The applicant / accused No.8 Mahesh Damu Pandhare is at liberty to apply for Passport from Passport Authority.

- 3 This Court has no objection for issuing the Pass-port to the present applicant / accused No.8 after due verification.
- 4 Pandharpur Gramin Police Station is directed to conduct verification of application filed by applicant.
- 5 Applicant/accused No.8 is granted permission to go abroad for period of 15 days.
- 6 Application is disposed off accordingly.
