Complaint present today. It be checked and registered. Complainant appeared and tendered his Affidavit as Ex.CW-1/A and documents as Ex.C-1 to Ex.C-11 and learned counsel for the complainant has closed the preliminary evidence on behalf of the complainant. Arguments on the point of summoning of accused. Heard.

The complainant has alleged that the accused in discharge of his legal liability issued the cheque in question to him which was dishonoured when presented in the bank due to insufficiency of funds. Within the time frame stipulated in the Negotiable Instrument Act, the complainant appeared before the Court and filed this complaint.

From the affidavit on oath filed by complainant and the documents Ex. C1 to C-11 attached with the affidavit, it appears that there is sufficient ground to proceed against the accused for commission of offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act. Accordingly, notice issued to accused is hereby ordered to be summoned to face trial for commission of offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act for 28.9.2026 on filing of PF/RC, Speed Post/approved Courier Service. Summons be sent dasti, if desired. The copy of complaint, relevant documents along with list of witnesses be sent along with the summons. If the service could not be effected by any of the above means then affixation should be done as per Section 65 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1972 and let the statement of process-server be recorded. Complainant is at liberty to accompany with the process-server for service of summons.
