**Claim :- Petition for grant of Succession Certificate
U/Section 372 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925.**

JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 23rd April, 2026)

This application is for grant of Succession Certificate under Section 372 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925.

Brief facts of applicants' case are as follows :-

02. The applicants state that, their father Nana Kshetri Shivsharan was died on 06.02.2004. Their mother namely Gangabai @ Gangubai Nana Shivsharan died on 15.12.2019. Their brother Ankush Nana Shivsharan died issueless on 24.04.2021. Their brother namely Ankush Shivsharan was having Demat account Client ID No. 80525937 attached with IDBI bank account No.478104000001403. An amount, as stated in petition, is pending in said bank account as well as in Demat account. The applicants state that, previously they filed application for succession certificate having Civil M.A. No. 45/2022. They submitted that, succession certificate was issued in said Civil M.A., pertaining to amount of deceased Ankush Nana Shivsharan. They state that, they came to know the fact that deceased Ankush is having account with IDBI bank. At the time of inquiry, they

got knowledge of Demat account of deceased. They state that, their mother was nominee to said account. She also died on 15.12.2019. Therefore, the bank asked the applicants to submit succession certificate for settlement of claim. Therefore, applicants have filed this application for succession certificate. They state that, there are no legal heir to deceased Ankush Nana Shivsharan, except the applicants. The applicants state that, they need Succession Certificate in order to get that amount. Therefore, they have filed this application for Succession Certificate. The applicants prayed to allow application.

03. Notice of application (with list Exh.8) was published in daily “Swabhimani Chava” newspaper. However, in response to the same, nobody appeared to object the claim of applicants.

04. Following points have arise for my consideration and I have given findings thereon for the reasons stated thereunder.

REASONS

05. In order to support their contention, the applicants led evidence of applicant No.3 (Exh.9). They filed documents vide list Exh.4. The applicants closed their evidence by filing pursis (Exh.10).

AS TO POINT NO. 01 :

06. Heard Advocate of applicants. In order to support the contention raised in application, the applicants led evidence of applicant No.3 (Exh.9). I have gone through evidence of applicants and the documents filed in support of the same. The applicants deposed that, there are no legal heirs to deceased Ankush Nana Shivsharan except the applicants. Ankush Nana Shivsharan died on 24.04.2021. The applicants are his sisters and they need succession certificate to withdraw the amount pending in the IDBI Bank saving account No.478104000001403 and Demat account (client ID 80525937). They prayed to issue succession certificate. Publication was issued in newspaper. However, nobody appeared and opposed application. Therefore, there is no reason to disbelieve the contention of the applicants as it remained unchallenged. The applicants have already obtained succession certificate in Civil M A. No.45/2022, as deposed by the applicant No.3 in evidence. Therefore, it appears that there are no legal heirs to deceased Ankush Nana Shivsharan, except the applicants.

07. Thus, in view of above oral and documentary evidence, I find the applicants are entitled for succession certificate on depositing necessary Court fees. Hence, in view of above, I answer point No.01 *'in affirmative'*.

AS TO POINT NO. 02 :

08. In view of reasons given to point No.1, application is liable to be allowed. Hence, I proceed to pass following order :

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Issue succession certificate in the name of applicants, so as to enable them to withdraw an amount, mentioned in petition, alongwith an interest accrued thereon, on payment of requisite Court fees and subject to executing indemnity bond by them.
3. Applicants to file correct statement of account as on today, so as to enable to mention correct amount in succession certificate and also to enable to determine Court fees as well as to mention the amount of indemnity bond.
