ORDER BELOW EXH.5 & 40 IN RCS NO.594/2022
(OLD RCS NO.1012/2019)

The plaintiff has submitted application Exh.5 that suit property may not be transferred by any mode to disposal of this suit. On which my learned predecessor has granted ex-parte temporary injunction against defendant. This application is pending from 27/09/2019. Defendant No.1 has submitted his counterclaim below Exh.39 and claimed a relief of perpetual injunction. He has submitted application Exh.40 not to create third party interest and thereby claimed a temporary injunction.

2. Heard learned advocate of plaintiff. The defendant and his learned advocate are absent. The suit is for declaration of ownership and for perpetual injunction. Both parties i.e. plaintiff and defendant No.1 have claimed temporary injunction regarding not to create third party interest. Considering the allegations against each other both parties are directed to maintain status-quo in respect of not to create third party interest in the suit property.
