

Order below Exh. 5

Plaintiffs filed T.I. application for temporary injunction. Today Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs prayed for 'status-quo' against defendant. It is contented that, Exh.5 for temporary injunction is pending but there are chances that defendant will obstruct in the suit property. Plaintiffs have possession and rights in the suit property. If defendant will obstruct the plaintiffs and if status quo is not granted, it will create multiplicity of proceedings. It is necessary to grant status-quo order to maintain the position. Hence, it is prayed to grant status-quo order till say of defendant.

2. Perused application. Heard ld. Advocate for plaintiffs at length. The plaintiffs have moved Exh.5 against defendant. Whether Plaintiffs have rights in the suit property or not, it will decide later on. The urgency is considerable. The rights of the plaintiffs in the suit property is the main question in the suit.

3. Considering this the application needs to be allowed till filing of say of defendant. All parties including plaintiffs and defendant are directed to maintain 'Status quo' order till filing of say of defendant.

4. Parties are directed to argue on Exh.5 next date.
