

**ORDER BELOW EXH.NO.1**

The case is taken in special drive. The instant case is summons case in respect of offence punishable under section 65(e) of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act. The accused is absent since inception. C.A. Report is not filed on record. In absence of C.A. report, there is no prospectus of the case ending in conviction. In the circumstances, it is quite difficult to proceed with the matter. The Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in **Mulchand Raka Vs State of Maharashtra 1996 (1) Bom. C.R. 316** held that section 258 of Cr.P.C. can be resorted to where the special or unusual circumstances exists such as non appearance of the accused before the Court for considerable time, which make it difficult or impossible for the Magistrate to proceed with the case in a normal way and in such situation without any hindrance the provision of Section 258 of Cr.P.C. (Section 281 of B.N.S.S) can be resorted to. The said ratio is aptly applicable to the instant case, as the police machinery is negligent in securing the presence of the accused. Therefore it is difficult to proceed with the case in a normal way. Hence, this is the fit case to take resort to Section 258 of Cr.P.C. (Section 281 of B.N.S.S). Hence, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

- 1] The proceeding is stopped vide Section 258 of Cr.P.C. (Section 281 of B.N.S.S) with liberty to the prosecution to revive the proceeding on the arrest or securing presence of the accused by showing justifiable grounds.

- 2] Bail bonds of the accused, if any, stands cancelled/ cash security, if any, be forfeited and credited to the Government.
- 3] Seized muddemal i.e. liquor be disposed of according to law and other muddemal, if any, be destroyed after appeal period is over.
- 4] The original police paper be retained in 'C' file for their use in the event of re-opening the case under section 337(5) of the B.N.S.S.
