Claim: Application under Section 2 & 3 of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827 for grant of Legal Heir Certificate.

ORDER

(Dt. 13/03/2026)

- 1) Applicants are seeking certificate of legal heir under Section 2 of the

Bombay Regulation Act, 1827.

2) **The application, in brief, is as under :-**

Grandfather of applicant namely Namdev @ Namu Balaku Mahar (Salave) was died on 18.12.1965 and grandmother of namely Gunabai @ Guna Namdev Salave (Mahar) also died on 02.09.1949. Deceased Namdev and Gunabai had only one son namely Sadashiv Namdev Salave who is father of applicants, he was also died on 03.06.2000. The mother of applicants namely Babanbai Sadashiv Salave was died on 02.05.1984. Therefore, except the applicants, there is no legal heirs to deceased Namdev @ Namu Balaku Mahar (Salave). Hence, the present application.

3) Citation Notices came to be published in daily newspaper 'Daily Janmat' at Exh.23, dated 12.11.2025. This Court has not received any objection regarding this application.

4) Heard, learned counsel Smt. J. D. Gejage for the applicants

5) Following points arise for determination and I have recorded my findings against them for the reasons mentioned below :-

No.	Points	Findings
1	Whether the applicants are entitled to get legal heir certificate of deceased Namdev @ Namu Balaku Mahar (Salave) under Section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827 ?	Yes.
2	What order ?	As per final order

REASON**AS TO POINT NO. 1 :-**

6) Applicant No.3 Jaykumar Sadashiv Salave has filed affidavit of evidence at Exh. No.11 for himself and on behalf of applicant No. 1 and 2 and reiterated the contents of the original application in conformity. The applicants have also filed on record death certificate of deceased Namdev @ Namu Balaku Mahar (Salave), Guna Namdev Salave (Mahar), Sadashiv Namdev Salave and Babanbai Sadashiv Salave at Exh.16 to 19, verified xerox copies of adhar cards at Exh. 20 to 22 and certified copy of ration-card at Exh. 24.

7) After considering the affidavit and documentary evidence which placed on record, I find that the applicants are only legal heirs of deceased Namdev @ Namu Balaku Mahar (Salave). Therefore, applicants are entitled to get certificate of legal heirs. Hence, I answer point No.1 in affirmative.

AS TO POINT No. 2: -

8) In view of affirmative finding to point No.1, application deserves to be allowed. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Issue legal heir certificate in the name of applicant Nos.1 to 3 that they are legal heirs of deceased Namdev @ Namu Balaku Mahar (Salave).
- 3) Applicants are directed to pay Court fees as per rules.
