Defendant No. 4 has filed the present application to set aside no written statement order.

2. It is asserted that, it is bound to give W.S. within time but defendant No. 4 is residing her fathers house at Pune for her bread and butter. Due to which, defendant was unable to remain present before the Court and file W.S. She has not intentionally delayed for filing W.S. Hence prayed for setting aside no written statement order passed against her.

3. Plaintiff filed the say on the said application and stated that, the application is false and illegal. The contents in the application are false. Hence, prayed for rejection of the application. Plaintiff further stated that, if court comes to the conclusion of allowing the application cost of Rs. 1000/- be imposed on defendant.

4. Perused the application and say. It reveals that, defendant is a woman and she resides at Pune for her bread and butter. Due to she was unable to remain present before the court and file W.S. within time. Therefore, it is necessary for the just decision of the case that, the written statement should be taken on record. Therefore, considering the say of the plaintiff and the circumstances narrated by the defendant it will be proper to give an opportunity to file the written statement subject to reasonable cost towards the delay. Considering the above facts, I pass the following order :

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. No written statement order passed is hereby set aside,

defendant No. 4 is permitted to file the written statement on record subject to cost of Rs.200/- be given to the plaintiff.
