

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT-23

Accused no.1 prayed for releasing him on bail. He submitted that he is in jail. He is ready to furnish bail and ready abide all the terms and conditions which will be imposed upon him while releasing him on bail. The ld. A.P.P strongly opposed the application. He submitted that, the accused has committed serious offence and if he released on bail he will be absconded. Even he will tamper with the prosecution witnesses. Hence prayed for rejection of the application. Heard both parties. The record shows that previously accused no.1 was enlarged on bail. He was absent so non-bailable warrant issued against him and in execution of non-bailable warrant he produced before on 16/06/2023. Since 16/06/2023 accused no.1 is in jail. Between this period, the prosecution failed to secure the presence of witnesses. If the prosecution failed to secure the presence of witnesses then no purpose will be served by keeping the accused in jail. Considering this situation, accused no.1 is required to be released on bail. Before doing so, it is necessary to recover the amount of forfeited bond as accused no.1 jumped over his previous bail bond. Accused no.1 shown his occupation as laborer. He is in jail. Considering this, accused no.1 is released on PR bond of Rs.15,000/- with SB of like amount on payment of Rs.500/- as a penalty towards forfeited bond amount Exh.3 with condition to remain present on each date, failure to which, his bail bond will be forfeited.
