ORDER

Accused-applicant Krishan Dev has filed this application for bail in the above noted case.

2. Notice of this bail application was given to the learned APP for the state who has opposed the bail application.

3. I have heard learned APP for the state as well as learned counsel for the accused/applicant and have gone through the file very carefully.

As per the prosecution version on 22.05.2019, accused along with co-accused have stolen 17 batteries from railway hut no.08 and sold the said stolen property at the shop of Raj Kumar (also co-accused) out of said stolen property, some articles were recovered by the police after conducting a raid. The applicants are in custody since 10.09.2019. Co-accused has

already admitted on bail. Culmination of the trial may take considerable time. No useful purpose shall be served by detaining the accused in judicial custody. Hence, accused-applicants are admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹10,000/- with one surety in like amount. Record of this application be annexed with the remand papers.
